One Schoolhouse Mathematics Courses

Upper level mathematics courses beyond Calculus not offered at Sion will be taught and administrated through One Schoolhouse (www.oneschoolhouse.org) and facilitated by Sion’s Math department chair during a designated hour of the day. The cost of these courses, as well as the enrollment process, will be handled by the school.

These math courses fulfill the Sion graduation requirement for four years of math. Because they are facilitated by Sion faculty, the grade for these courses will be calculated into the student’s GPA and will be recorded on the student’s high school transcript. Students taking AP courses will sit for the AP exam at Sion in May. The cost of the AP exam will be the responsibility of the student.

One Schoolhouse AP Computer Science

AP Computer Science is an optional course that can be taken through One Schoolhouse (www.oneschoolhouse.org). Sion will enroll the student in the course, but the student is responsible for the \$750 cost of the course as well as any additional fees associated with the class. This online class is considered an independent study course and the student is responsible for all work associated with the class. The course must be completed before the student graduates. The letter grade for AP Computer Science will be reported on the Sion transcript, however, this course is not calculated into the student’s GPA.

MU High School Courses

American Government and World Religions are optional courses, yet still fulfill graduation requirements. They are designed as independent study courses with deadlines, enrollment fees and book fees that usually total approximately \$250. Students are responsible for enrolling in the course. Letter grades are reported on the Sion transcript, however, these courses are not calculated into the student's GPA. Students must submit the School Approval Form from MU High along with this form to be enrolled.

Student expectations for MU High School courses are as follows:

- ✓ Courses taken in the summer must be completed no later than 1st Quarter Midterm (September 11, 2017). The midterm exam must be taken by July 10, 2017.
- ✓ Two weeks in advance, the student will request the exam and make arrangements with her counselor to have the exam proctored at Sion.
- ✓ The student will initiate contact with her counselor if problems arise.
- ✓ The student will use the Independent Study Planning Sheet (available at mizzouk12online.missouri.edu/) to plan and document course progress.

Blue Valley CAPS and Other Off-site Courses

Special arrangements can be made to take courses off-site. These are dependent on the student's schedule of classes and graduation requirements. Students should consult with their counselor to develop a plan for off-site courses.
