



COLLEGE APPLICATION BOOTCAMP: Essay, Resume, & Application Clinic

Want to get a jumpstart on the college application process and lighten your load for the fall? Sign up for Sion's very own College Essay, Resume & Application clinic! Sessions are limited to 18 students and spots are given on a first-come basis.

When: Session 1: May 31 - June 7; 8:30am-11am (6 day clinic -W,TH,F,M,T, W)
Session 2: May 31 - June 7; 12pm-2:30pm (6 day clinic - W,TH,F,M,T,W)
Session 3*: August 1 - August 8; 3pm-5:30pm (6 day clinic - T,W,TH,F,M,T)
**Session 3 is open to non-Sion students (Class of 2018), in addition to Sion students.*

Why: By the end of the class, students will have completed the following:

- A final draft of your Common Application college essay
- A list of a supplemental essay topics
- A final draft of your activities/leadership resume
- A start on the Common Application

Highlights: Summer is the perfect time to **prepare for your senior year**, without the commitments, distractions, and work load of the school year. Take time to **hone your “voice”** through the writing process, and **receive constructive feedback** on your essay from a college admissions professional; **reflect on “fit”** in the college search process, and **gain valuable information** on the college application/admission process.

Who: Co-taught by Melissa Wilcox, Senior AP English Teacher & Erin Stein, Director of College Counseling.

College admissions veteran, Bridget Gramling, will also evaluate all essays. Mrs. Gramling brings 20+ years of college admission and application reading experience at institutions including University of Dallas, Saint Louis University, William Jewell College and St. John's University.

How: After registration, students need to share a sample essay (*one written in junior English class*) via Google Docs with Mrs. Wilcox (mwilcox@ndsion.edu) by Tuesday, May 23rd. Please include subject heading, “sample essay - student name”. Students can pick up a copy of the textbook in Ms. Stein's office during Finals Week.
